

10-11 year old boys: -35, +35 (1:30 min 6 IPPON)

12-13 year old boys: -45, -50, +50 (1:30 min 6 IPPON)

14-15 year old cadet boys: -52, -57, -63, +63 (2 min 6 IPPON)

16-17 year old males: -61, -68, -76, +76 (2 min 6 IPPON)

18+ absolute category males, prize money (3 min 8 IPPON)

Category with less than four players is combined with another category

10-13 year old girls: -40, +40 (1:30 min 6 IPPON).

14-15 year old cadet girls: -54, +54 (2 min 6 IPPON).

16-17 year old females: -57, +57 (2 min IPPON 6)

16+ absolute category females (2 min 8 IPPON)

Entry fee

LTL 70 (EUR 20) for participation in one event, LTL 120 (EUR 35) for participation in two events, LTL 140 (EUR 40) for participation in three events.

The fee for athletes of clubs that delegate referees is as follows: LTL 50 (EUR 15) for participation in one event, LTL 85 (EUR 25) for participation in two events, LTL 105 (EUR 30) for participation in three events.

Awards

I place winners will be awarded cups, medals and diplomas, II and two III place (only Kumite categories) winners will be awarded medals and diplomas.

18+ Male Open Kumite

I place – EUR 200; II place – EUR 100; III place – EUR 50

Team Baltic Cup Karate Championship

Cup presented to the team that collected the most points.
I place – 5 points, II place – 3 points, III place – 1 point.

Note

Mandatory for athletes: gum shield, gloves, chest protection (for females), red and blue belts. For karatekas of 14 years of age and older – red or blue Futa. Competitors must arrange their health insurance. LKA – the organizer of the championship – does not assume any liability for injuries incurred during the competition and does not compensate any damage.
