## Rules & Regulations

## Championship will be conducted strictly as per the rules of WKF

1. The Technical committee will be final decision taker.
2. Organizing committee will not responsible for any injuries during the tournament, first aid facility will be provided.
3. Participants should have their own gloves and guards. Only white unmarked karate GI is allowed.
4. The decision of chief referee will be final, Objection against the same is Misbehavior with the organizers can result to disqualification of whole team or Individual.
5. Protest fees will be Rs. 5000/- if any.
6. Official must be in uniform (Grey Pant, White Shirt and concerned Tie).
7. In all categories 8 participants are must. In case of incomplete participants, that weight categories can be mixed with next weight categories and same rule applicable in kata events.
8. All students must have Date of Birth certificate. Those who reached up to medal checked by organizing committee. If he or she will not have certificate, can be disqualified.
9. Entry fees will not be refundable at any circumstances.
10. Two-passport size photos of each participants and teachers are must for I-card for entrance in tournament & mess.
11. Organizers has the right to alter / cancel any event / weight category.
12. The legal jurisdiction in any case will be in Delhi only.

Note: - Please confirm your participation along with number of students on phone or E-mail before 30 November 2010, so that necessary arrangements could be made.
