afterwards Kumite Team
The different disciplines are battled out completely, incl. final fight.
The award ceremony takes place in two up to three groups, each after:
- Kata Individual and Team
- Kumite Individual or Kumite Team

Weighing: There will be no weighing for participants. Tests are conducted randomly.

Competition Disciplines and Age group classification:

Only Goju-Ryu-Kata is allowed in the Kata disciplines, the Kumite disciplines are open to any styles!

With less than five participants in a Kata discipline, the age group classification is not applicable.
With less than five participants in a Kumite discipline, the weight classification is not applicable. However, if the required number of participants can still not be reached, the age group classification is no longer applicable.

Kumite Team

Each team is allowed to have one team member born one year before. This means that e.g. a youth team is allowed to have one team member born in 1997.

Kata Team

Pupils Female	from 7th Kyu	born in 1998 and after
Pupils Male	from 7th Kyu	born in 1998 and after
Seniors Female	from 6th Kyu	born in 1997 and before
Seniors Male	from 6th Kyu	born in 1997 and before

Each team is allowed to start with one team member belonging to the next higher or lower age group. This means that e.g. a pupils team is allowed to have one team member born in 1997 and before, a seniors team is allowed to have a team member born in 1998 and after.

Eligibility:

Only the following may participate as competitors in the International German Goju-Ryu-Cup:

- Karateka who possess a Sport Book (Sport Pass) of a member of WKF. This Sport Book must show a valid license stamp for the current year and the Dojo membership. Karateka with a dual membership must possess a Sport Book showing the competition eligibility and the valid Kyu/Dan grade,
- Karateka who have a certificate showing that they are „Fit to Fight“. A medical assessment must not be older than 12 months (only for athletes who are younger than 18 years old at the day of the competition).

Competition rules and regulations:

The rules and regulations of WKF and DKV (German Karate Federation) generally apply. Exceptions to this are specified in the announcement.

Only Goju-Ryu-Kata are allowed.

Kata Individual

The elimination system with repechage will be applied.

Children:

In the first two rounds, the contestants must perform a different Kata in each round. Once performed a Kata may be repeated, but not in the following round. The final Kata is chosen by the contestants (two Katas are required).

Youth, Cadets, Juniors, Seniors and master class:

In the first three rounds, the contestants must perform a different Kata in each round. Once performed a Kata may be repeated, but not in the following round. The final Kata is chosen by the contestants (three Katas are required).

Kata Team

Each team consists of three persons and max. two substitutes; otherwise as described in Kata Individual.

In the bouts for medals of Kata Competition (final and semi-final), both teams will perform their chosen Kata in the usual way. They will then perform a demonstration of the meaning of the Kata (BUNKAI).

Kumite Individual

Bras. Elimination system with repechage will be applied.

The pool winners are in the final. Each winner of the repechage round takes third place. The exception to this is:

With up to five contestants in one discipline, a round allows all contestants in a pool to fight once (round robin).

With six to eight contestants, two equal groups are formed. All contestants of the respective group are allowed to enter the mat fighting once (round robin). The winners of both groups fight against

each other in the final. Each winner of the repechage round takes third place. Table system.

Kumite Team

Each team consists of three persons and max. two substitutes; otherwise as described in Kumite Individual. The team composition can be chosen. There is no club membership required.

Each team must compete with at least two persons.

In the age groups Children and Youth, the smallest athlete will start.

The next taller one will follow and so on.

Duration of bout and Scoring:

Point system for all fights

The new competition rules will be applied.

Duration of fight:

MC, Seniors, Juniors, Cadets Individual and Team	2 min. eff.
Youth, Children Individual and Team	1,5 min. eff.

Protective

Fist and foot mitts (red/blue) and gum shield are **equipment:** compulsory.

Shin pads (white, max. 1 cm thick or red / blue) are allowed.

WKF approved body protection is allowed.

Contrary to the WKF regulations, no face mask is allowed.

Additionally:

Male: groin guard is compulsory.

Female: Chest protector is compulsory for youth, cadets, seniors and master class.

The use of dental braces is only allowed on condition that the contestant accepts full responsibility for any injuries. Minors must have a written consent from their parents. This parental consent must be submitted at the start of the competition.

Coach:

In preparation of the competition, each coach is obliged to inquire about the rules and regulations of the DKV (German Karate Federation) as well as the content of the competition announcement. One coach is allowed for up to five competitors of a dojo.

Registration:

The attached or enclosed registration forms must be typed.

Single discipline per contestant and discipline	12.- €
Team disciplines per team and discipline	25.- €

Registration requires the payment of the fees!

Exception:
Foreign contestants are allowed to pay the entry fee in cash on site on the day of the competition.

Qualification: The winners of the Kata Individual disciplines are qualified for the next German Championships in their age group provided that they fulfil the conditions stated in the regulations of the DKV (German Karate Federation) (Kyu grade, DKV membership). The participation at the respective German Championship must be announced at the latest six weeks before the Championship. These participation announcements must be addressed to Mr. Peter Steinbauer, the Competition Manager of the GKD (German Goju-Ryu Karate Federation)
