Disciplines	Kata individual and kumite individual; female and male separated. In kata teams no separation between male and female katateams; mixed teams are allowed. The organization has the right to regroup special disciplines whenever an insufficient number of subscriptions per category occurs. Please, bear in mind that karate passports can be checked.

Entry fee spectators	€ 5,00. There are limited seats available (220 seats).

Time schedule	<p>08.30 uur doors open 09.00 uur start kata competition cat. A1, A2, A3 10.30 uur start kata competition cat. A4, A5 12.30 uur start katateam competition 13.00 uur start kumite competition cat. B1, B2, B3 16.30 uur start kumite competition cat. B4, B5, B6</p> <p>Timings as mentioned are estimated. Medal ceremony will be immediately after the category finals.</p>
Kata rules	<p>Cat. A1, A2, A5 – Free selection. Kata's can be repeated until the final. In the final competitors must perform a kata which has not been demonstrated before in the competition. Kata's will be demonstrated by both competitors at the same time.</p> <p>Cat. A3, A4 – Free selection. In each round another kata has to be demonstrated. A demonstrated kata cannot be repeated. Kata's will be demonstrated separately.</p> <p>Cat. A5 – Free selection. Kata's can be repeated until the final. In the final competitors must perform a kata which has not been demonstrated before in the competition. Kata's will be demonstrated separately.</p> <p>Cat. C1, C2 – Free selection. Kata's can be repeated. There is no bunkai in the final.</p>
Kumite rules	<p>WKF protection rules for male and female. All competitors must have red and blue gloves, foot/shin protection and belts. Mouth piece is mandatory. Jock straps (male competition) are mandatory. In female competition breast protection is advised. In all categories facemasks are not mandatory.</p> <p>Time per match in category B1, B2, B3 is 1½ minute. Category B4, B5 and B6 is 2 minutes.</p>
Weight category	<p>Open category. In case there are too many competitors in a category there will be a + and – category.</p> <p>Watchout: in case of doubt, weighing is possible. Change of category on competition day is not possible.</p>
Coach rules	<p>One extra coachcard per 10 competitors. Coaching is only allowed in the competition area in trainingsuit.</p>
Referee	<p>We kindly ask to subscribe an official referee if possible. Please provide names in advance on the entry form or send names by mail to the organization.</p>
Important	<p>The organization of the Rotterdam Cup is not responsible for missing property and/or for injuries during the competition day. Participation is on your own risk.</p>
