Lisbon is the capital and the largest city of Portugal, with a population of around 2.7 million people.

Lisbon is recognized as a global city because of its importance in finance, commerce, media, entertainment, arts, international trade, education and tourism.

Lisbon is one of the oldest cities in the world, and the oldest in Western Europe, predating other modern European capitals such as London, Paris and Rome by centuries. Julius Caesar made it a municipium called Felicitas Julia, adding to the name Olissipo. Ruled by a series of Germanic tribes from the 5th century, it was captured by the Moors in the 8th century. In 1147, the Crusaders under Afonso Henriques reconquered the city and since then it has been a major political, economic and cultural center of Portugal



- Access to the competition area will only be permited with the official registration card and only during the athetle competition
- Body Protector Recommended for all Categories
- Press authorization may be requested
- Public is not allowed inside the competition area
