Sopot Open 2016 Summer Championships

Tournament will be held at the Hala Haffnera, 81-817 Sopot, Jakuba Goyki 7, on Saturday 15th July 2017 from 09.00 to 15.00.

Please note that competitors must supply their own equipment. Red and blue mitts, red and blue belts, shin and foot protection is compulsory for kumite for all age groups as well as mouth guards (gum shields). However we do not insist on WKF approved types so long as it is safe and within reasonable dimensions.
