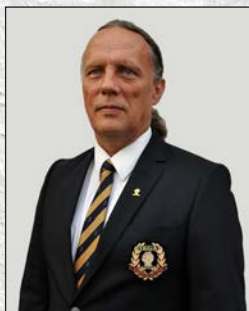

INTRODUCTION

DEAR SPORT FRIENDS,



20 years have passed since the first Budapest Open international karate championship. At that time, when this series started, I was the coach of the Hungarian team. My goal was to create a local opportunity for the best Hungarian competitors to challenge themselves against the top fighters from other countries. At the beginning, we organized the competition for adults, with participants from only a few countries. I remember how happy we were to see when competitors from ten countries took part in the event. We listened to the advice of Hungarian and foreign coaches, and extended the program to juniors. Thanks to this, more and more competitors entered the championship, so we decided to make it a two-day event. Every single year, we tried to prepare a new surprise for the participants, which they really appreciated. Some countries and clubs have entered many generations of competitors to Budapest, and they could not imagine the start of the season without the Open. We are happy to see that the number of participating countries and competitors is steadily increasing. In 2016, the 19th Budapest Open broke all records, and attracted 1200 registrations from 29 countries. In addition to quantity, we focus on quality as well. Each year, we try to attract the best competitors to Hungary to set even higher standards. We are proud to meet many Budapest Open participants at the World and European Championships, as well as in the Premier League. Many World and European Championship medalists have entered our tournament, from Malaysia to Chile and from South Africa to Norway. Neighbouring countries include Budapest Open among their European and World Championship qualification events, which makes sure that Hungarian and foreign spectators see a really high standard event each year.

We have special plans for the 20th Budapest Open, too. As the new name of the 20th Budapest Open Hayashi Cup shows, a new company has found this event worth sponsoring. Thanks to their support, we are introducing two prized categories: open (no weight divisions) male and female kumite, with a first prize of €500, second prize of €300, and two third prizes of €100. We hope that this will encourage even more top contestants from more countries to enter this competition.

Please consider the age of the competitors at the date of the tournament!

COMPETITION CATEGORIES: Individual kata and kumite.

RULES: WKF system - full repechage will be applied, with following changes: kata categories from 5 to 13 years old, 2 competitors perform the kata simultaneously, except for medal matches. In medal matches aka and au perform the kata separately.

1.5 min. for kumite: age 6-13

2 min. for kumite: cadets

kata: age 6-7, 8-9, 10-11 – at least 2 different kata required
age 12-13 – at least 3 different kata required
cadets – WKF system – full repechage will be applied.

REGISTRATION/WEIGH IN: 17th September from 7.00 till 8.30 a.m. at the Sport hall.

PROTECTION: Gum shields, WKF type red and blue mitts, shin pads and foot protection, for women chest protection over 12 years are mandatory.

ENTRY FEE: Individual categories 18 Euro.

PRIZES: 1-3 places: medals and certificates, the winner of each category will receive a cup and special award offered by the sponsors. The winners of senior kumite and kata categories: karate gi, special prizes offered by Székely Budo-Sport Kft. and other prizes offered by the sponsors of the tournament.

DRAW: 15th September, 2017.

PROTEST: The protest has to be submitted in writing to the referee council of the tournament and 50 Euro protest fee has to be deposited. If the protest is accepted by the referee council, the fee is going to be refunded.

REFEREES: Referees are going to be delegated by the Hungarian Karate Federation. Foreign qualified referees are welcome. Please, apply in writing to nominate your referee!

RESPONSIBILITY: The organization committee will not bear any responsibility of any kinds of damages or losses.

ATTENTION: All competitors must have their own red and blue belts.

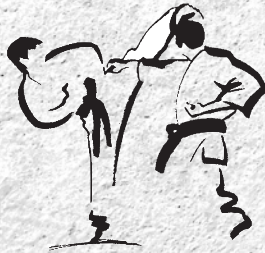
